# PREMIUM CAMPING AT THE MUSTER APPLIES TO:

# <u>Nashville Park and Nashville Ridge (\$495.00 per site)</u> – There will be a maximum of 4 sites per booking available.

- Nashville Park and Nashville Ridge are premium campsites ideal for caravans, Rvs and larger vehicles.
- Located close to the precinct.
- Maximum 6 people per camp site.
- Shuttle bus stops are located just outside the areas.
- The sites are unpowered and approximately 100m<sup>2</sup>.
- Exclusive amenities in each area, these will be available form 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2025.
- Nashville Park sites are all flat. Many unsafe trees have been removed for the 2025 festival. Refer to the map.
- Take up residence from August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025 please note: NO CAMPING prior to the 9<sup>th</sup> August as Nashville will be used for queuing for rope off.

## Slim Dusty Drive (\$760 per site) - SOLD OUT

Slim Dusty drive is located adjacent to the festival. These sites are extremely sort after and held tightly. Sites are allocated to the same site holder each year. When sites become available it will be offered to the next on the waiting list. If you wish to be added to the waiting list, please contact the Muster office.

To purchase a camp site ticket to the Slim Dusty Campground for the 2025 Gympie Music Muster, you and all authorised campers associated with your site must agree to the full terms of the **Slim Dusty Access Policy**. These restrictions have been implemented for the safety, protection, and wellbeing of all working at or attending the event. This is particularly important in 2025 as the pre-festival entertainment will be held in the Crowbar. All restrictions will be always enforced at the sole discretion of Event Management and are subject to change without notice during and after the 2025 Event.

## Slim Dusty Access policy

- Slim Dusty Campground fee will be \$760.00 per site.
- Slim Dusty Campground access will be available from 8:00am Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- Access between Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2025 will be <u>STRICTLY</u> only between the hours of 5:00am and 11:00am each day.
- There is absolutely no access into or out of Slim Dusty from 9:00am Wednesday
   27<sup>th</sup> August until 5:00am Monday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2025. You can only leave the campground during this time in the event of an emergency or a serious personal matter. Permission must be sought from the GMM administration.
- In the event of leaving during the closed periods, you cannot return your car unless it is during the open periods prior to the Muster. Car parking is available in the day car park.
- 2 cars per camp site is allowed <u>Cars must be parked within the allocated campsite</u>. Additional parking
  is available in the day car park. A shuttle bus service operates from noon on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> August to
  midnight Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025.
- It is the responsibility of the person booking the site to notify all associated people with the allocated camp site of the Slim Dusty Access Policy.



#### **GENERAL CAMPGROUND RULES APPLY**

## **Camping**

- Campsites are approximately 100m2.
- Maximum 6 people per camp site.
- Tents must be at least 2m apart.
- No dogs in the campground. This applies from 31 July 2025. Certified assistance dogs only are allowed refer to the Animals at the Muster fact sheet.
- Alfords Flat, Alfords Pocket and Blue Gum Ridge are quiet camping ONLY No loud music/parties or whip cracking allowed between 10pm – 7am.
- Generators are not permitted between 10pm and 6am. Please consider your neighbours.
- All amenities will gradually be available from August 23, 2025.
- Dump points are available in Nashville, Poulsen's Hill & Poulsen's Flat
- Campers must vacate campsite by Tuesday 2 September 2025.
- DO NOT ENTER WATER BODIES, IF YOU ENTER ANY WATER BODY THEN IT IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.

#### <u>Vehicles</u>

- Speed limit is 10km/hr.
- No unregistered vehicles are to be used on site. i.e. golf carts, side by sides unless authorised by GML. Mobility scooters are permitted.
- All road rules apply.
- No vehicle movement in the campgrounds between 5pm and 7am unless you are leaving the festival. Emergencies excluded. GML accepts no responsibility for any personal injury or property damage caused by patron vehicles.
- Disability parking at the bus turnaround is for day ticket holders with wheelchairs.
- Disability campers are to use the disability courtesy bus.
- Cars parked in the disabled carpark without the appropriate stickers will be towed.

#### **Fires**

- No fires between 9am and 4pm. All fires will be extinguished during the day.
- Further fire bans may apply on advice from QFS.
- All fires must be contained within a fire ring.
- 4m distance must be kept between a fire and tents or vehicles.
- Nothing is to be put in a fire ring that doesn't burn. i.e. metal.

### **Emergencies**

- Make yourself familiar with the closest emergency meeting point. These sites are marked with a name and number to quote in the event of an emergency.
- Medical emergencies: In the first instance call the on-site Medic. The number is displayed on the emergency call point sign. If no response, then call 000.
- On-site medic is available from Saturday 23 August 2025.
- A Security number is also displayed for all other emergencies.
